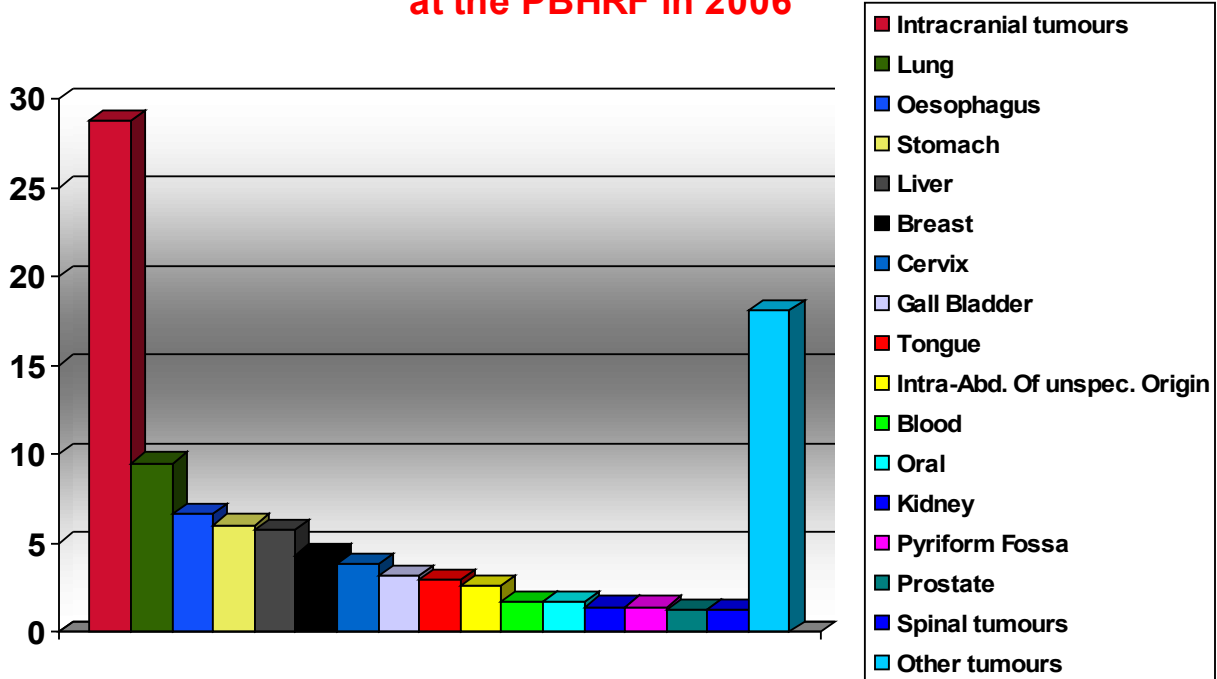
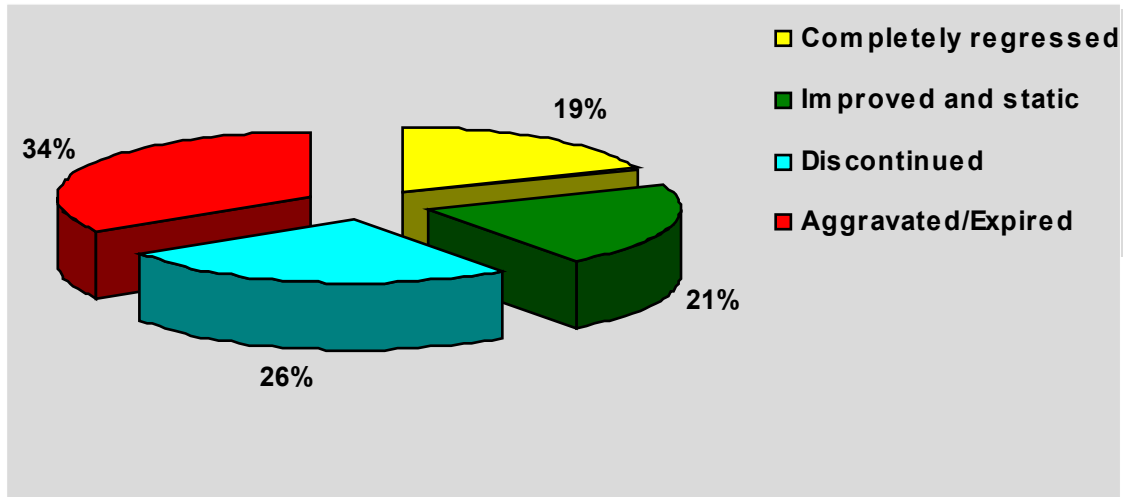


## Percentage of Different Malignant Tumor Cases seen at the PBHRF in 2006



The approximate percentage of different malignant tumor cases seen at the PBHRF clinics in the year 2006 are - intracranial tumours (28.1%) and malignant tumours originating from lung (9.3%), oesophagus (6.5%), stomach (5.8%), liver (5.6%), breast (4.2%), cervix (3.7%), gall bladder (3%), tongue (2.8%), and others.

## Results of Treatment of 17324 Malignant Tumor Cases (1990 – 2005)



This Graph shows general outcome of treatment of 17,324 cancer patients from 1990 to 2005 at our clinics. In 19% cases the malignant tumors were completely regressed which appeared to us very significant. In 21% cases they were static or improved after treatment. Over the last two years, there has been a spurt in the number of cancer cases visiting our clinics. It may be mentioned here that the above in-house figure is mainly based on those cases with complete documentation such as scan plates, biopsy slides and such, and the actual number of cancer cases under our treatment exceeds this figure. In general a significantly good response is found in all these cases. In brain tumour cases we are getting very good response in comparison to malignant tumours originating from other sites. One should note that the results given in this graph are based only on cases who did not take any previous conventional treatment and most of our patients belong to stage III and stage IV.

Thus presently it appears from all these findings that The Banerji Protocol of treatment with homeopathic medicines may be regarded as the future drug for cancer research and treatment for the benefit of mankind.
